## 13-week internship for Alaskans | Summer 2023

Since 2013, SCA's NPS Alaskans in Parks Program has provided internships for under-represented, diverse, and rural Alaskan residents interested in conservation

### PROGRAM DETAILS:

- Participate in a 3 to 4 day orientation in Anchorage, AK with all eleven members of the AIP program
- From orientation, interns will travel to their assigned NPS site to complete 12 weeks of service in the field

### BENEFITS:

- \$600 per week living allowance
- \$650 travel allowance
- Free housing or \$800 per month housing stipend
- Some positions eligible for AmeriCorps Education Award

### PROGRAM DATES:

Mid-May to Mid-August 2023

### POSITION DETAILS:

Positions range in focus in fields such as: Visitor Services/Interpretation, Wildlife Biology, Fisheries, Trail Work, Backcountry Ranger, Habitat Restoration, Museum Curatorial, Information Technology, and more!

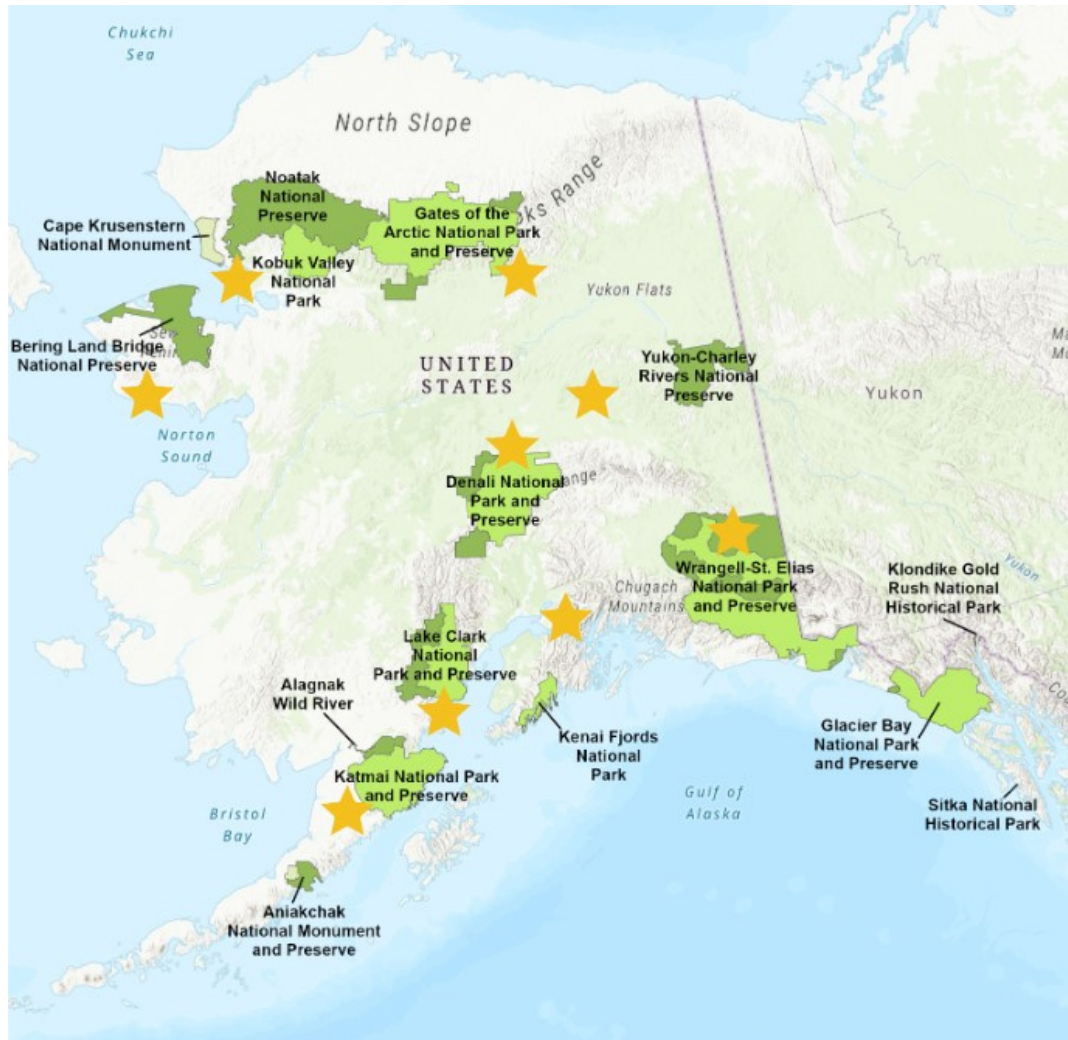
