Frequency Counts

The following results are based on 1,067 completed telephone interviews among a nationwide random sample of respondents age 15 to 25. The interviews were conducted March 17 through April 1, 2021.

The theoretical margin of error for the total sample size of 1,067 is plus or minus 3 percentage points on questions where opinion is evenly split. The theoretical margins of error for any sub-groups will be larger. The results presented here have not been weighted.

The results in the column labeled 2020 are based on the survey conducted February 14 through 21, 2021.
